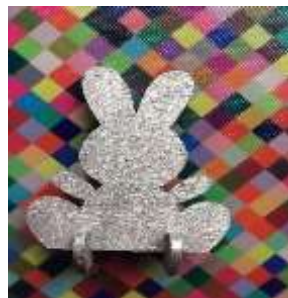
## Easter Raffle 2018
