Community Links – town council, local shops/businesses, other schools

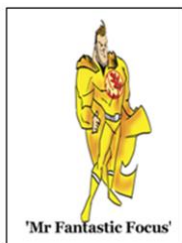
Master Classes – links with local schools with subject expert provision
