SAFEGUARDING

In the press recently, there has been much talk of new internet/social media crazes that involve 'dares' and potential self-harm. We won't be mentioning them here in any detail (if you'd like to enquire about this, please email mwhatley@stukeleymeadows.cambs.sch.uk) but are also aware that some of our children are talking openly about them. These 'crazes' are nothing new – they manifest themselves regularly with new names etc... The last time this happened, we had a number of children scared by their peers talking of what may/may not happen if these 'dares' were followed.

We have followed up our e-safety discussions from before half term about what children (or adults) should do if they see or hear of anything that makes them anxious. This involves talking to families/adults NOT sharing scare-stories with their peers. We have talked about this in assembly several times this week.

Please ensure you have open and honest chats at home about this – remember, the internet and social media can be amazing and 'sensible use' of them should be encouraged rather than using scare stories that might increase interest.

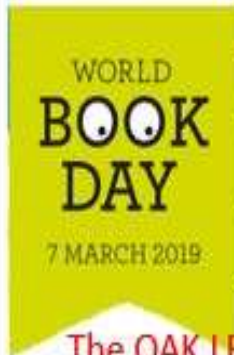
